HELP HER STAY IN SCHOOL AND RESTORE HER DIGNITY

This program involves the distribution of free sanitary towels and offering Adolescent Sexual Reproductive Health Education and Menstrual Hygiene Management among school going girls in Community and Rural Schools in Zambia. With a target of 1000 girls in 2019, this program intends to help these girls stay in school with the aim of reducing absenteeism, teenage pregnancy and improve school performance.

MILESTONE:

With the support from the Faith Arise management team, the Board of advisors and our esteemed donors and partners, on 14th September, 2019, Faith Arise distributed sanitary towels to 100 girls at Chainda Open Community School.

A total of three rounds of distribution was done in 2019, which saw us distribute sanitary towels to 100 girls in the 2019 academic year at Chainda Open School. We hope to raise this number in 2020.

2019 MENSTRUAL HYGIENE DAY



In partnership with the Ministry of General Education and Other partners,

Faith Arise took part in the celebrations of Menstrual Hygiene Day which were held in Chongwe on 28th May, 2019.



Some of the girls confirmed that they usually missed 3 to 6 days of school every month during their menstrual period due to a lack of sanitary towels.

We are hopeful that with increased support
